




## Edit and create new stitches


## Three variations of "Leaves on a string

- from Canada, Betty Biberdorf -

1	To open the Stitch Creator program, touch on Stitch Creator icon in the task bar.		2
2	To bring up a stitch, touch the Selection Menu.		
3	Touch • category 4; Decorative stitches • subcategory 3; Leaves and Flowers • stitch number 28	4. Decorative stitches	
4	We are going to remove the center flower from this stitch. Touch Multi-select icon to deselect pattern.

17	To save the stitch; touch the file folder in the options bar.	
18	Touch the open folder.	
19	Touch rename.	
20	Delete the default name (NewStitch.spx) a long touch on the Delete icon. Type in a new name for your stitch: "2leaves"	Enter new name

23 Open Stitch Creator again.



24 Touch the stitch you just added (just before the last leaf) or use the marking arrow to scroll to stitch #24/49. Touch Mulit-select icon to activate. 25 Touch or scroll up to stitch #2 to highlight the 26 first leaf. Touch mirror end to end. 27 To get a full view of the stitch close Stitch 28 Creator, by touching the Stitch Creator icon in the task bar. 00000 Your stitch should now look like this. 29 Save your new stitch as 2leaves\_mirror. (See point 17-21) À

If you would like you can go back into Stitch Creator and fine tune the stitch points between the leaves, i.e stitch points 3, 4 and 5.


When you are happy with your manipulated stitch save it as 2leaves\_mirror. It will overwrite the original you created.
