5D™ Design Creator 'Sunrise Apartments'

- Open 5D™ Embroidery Extra ⁵
- QuickLink to 5D[™] Design Creator . The ExpressDesign Wizard will open.
- 3. Choose Create Express Embroidery then click Next.
- 4. Click View Picture
- 5. Browse to Documents\5dembroidery\samples\5demb\pics2\fashion then click OK.
- 6. Select 1CFa14.png found on the bottom row, fourth column then click Next.
- 7. No Rotation is necessary, just click Next.
- 8. No additional cropping is needed, just click Next.
- On the Design Size page, select Fit Design to Hoop then click Change Hoop.
- 10. Set the Hoop Group to Pfaff® creative vision™.
- 11. Set the Hoop Size to 260mm x 200mm creative Elite Hoop.
- 12. Set the Orientation to Vertical then click OK followed by clicking Next.
- 13. On the Reduce Colors page, leave the colors as is, just click Next.
- 14. On the Choose Thread Colors page, set the Change All To Robison-Anton Rayon 40.
- 15. Under Background Color, notice the software determined black is the background color.
- 16. Click Pick Background Color then click in the white area at the bottom of the Source picture to change the background color to white.
- 17. Check Automatically Remove Background Color then click Next.
- 18. On the Fabric and Stitch Type Options page, leave the fabric as Woven.
- 19. Remove the checkmark from Design Underlay and leave the Stitch Type and Fill.
- 20. Click Next. The design is created.
- 21. Click Finish and the design will appear on the Create page of 5D™ Design Creator.
- 22. Click in the center blue section that looks like sun rays then right click to bring up the Area box.
- 23. On the Patterns tab, under Category, click the drop down arrow and choose Gradient & Lace.
- 24. Choose the pattern in the top row, third column (255) then click Apply.
- 25. Move the Area box by clicking on the top bar and sliding it to the right until you can see the section you just changed.
- 26. Go to the Density tab.
- 27. Put a check mark next to Gradient.
- 28. Leave Single Color Gradient selected.
- 29. Select the marker on the left then change the Density to 20.
- 30. Select the marker on the right then change the Density to 2.
- 31. Click Apply to see the change.
- 32. Go to the Options tab.





33. Set the Angle to 180 then click Apply. This will place the dense area at the top and the less dense area at the bottom.


- 34. Click OK to close the Area box.
- 35. Go to the Edit tab.
- 36. With the gradient section still selected, click the Tie command above it in the FilmStrip.
- 37. Right click on the Tie command listed in the FilmStrip and select Insert Color Change.
- 38. Select the Medium Yellow in the Standard Quick Colors (2326 Daffodil) then click OK. Only the sun section will be changed to yellow.
- 39. Go back to the Create tab.
- 40. Select the main background then right click to bring up the Area box.
- 41. Change the Pattern Category to Gradient & Lace.
- 42. Select the pattern in the top row, last column (256) then click Apply. Move the Area box over to the right to see the change.
- 43. Go to the Density tab.
- 44. Put a check mark next to Gradient.
- 45. Select Multicolor Gradient.
- 46. Select the marker on the left then click Thread Color Change ♥.
- 47. Type 2300 (Ice Blue) in the Find Thread box then click OK.
- 48. Click the marker on the right and click Thread Color Change ♥.
- 49. Type 2210 (Royal) in the Find Thread box then click OK.
- 50. Click Add Marker then slide the new marker to the right staying three notches to the left of the right marker.
- 51. Click Thread Color Change ♥ . Type 2523 (China Blue) in the Find Thread box then click OK.
- 52. Click Add Marker again and slide the new marker three notches to the right of the far left marker.
- 53. Click Thread Color Change ♥ Type 2524 (Country Blue) in the Find Thread box then click OK.
- 54. Click Apply to see the change.
- 55. Go to the Options tab.
- 56. Set the Angle to 0 then click Apply. This will place the light area at the top and the dark area at the bottom.
- 57. Click OK to close the Area box.
- 58. Go to the Edit tab.
- 59. On the FilmStrip, select 6 white Pattern Fill.
- 60. Hold down the Ctrl key on your keyboard.
- 61. Scroll down the FilmStrip and select Pattern Fill 51, 55 and 60.
- 62. Right click and choose Group Properties.
- 63. Set the Pattern Category to Climate then choose the pattern in the second row, second column (90).
- 64. Go to the Options tab.
- 65. Change the Angle to 333 then click OK.
- 66. Go back to the Create tab.
- 67. Using the Zoom bar, zoom in to 60%.
- 68. Click Overview and move the overview to the bottom section where the sun fill pattern is found.













- 69. Select the white section.
- 70. Move the Origin marker until the suns fall directly across the center of the white section.
- 71. Move the Origin o market in the other three sections as shown.
- 72. Click Zoom to Fit ...



- 73. Go to the Edit tab.
- 74. Click Insert Character A.
- 75. Set the Category to Decorative then choose Mirage UC 65-100mm.
- 76. Select the capital 'S' then click Insert. The S has been added at the end of the design.



77. Move the S on top of the sun as shown.



- 78. Go back to the Create tab to see the final results. This design is a little big, let's resize it!
- 79. Click Hoop ...
- 80. Leave the Hoop Group as My Hoops.
- 81. Click the drop down arrow next to Hoop Size and choose the 240mm x 150mm creative Master Hoop then click OK.
- 82. Click Save As and save the design in your Documents\5DEmbroidery\MyDesigns as Sunrise Apartments.can then click Save.
- 83. Click Save Embroidery

 Save the design in your MyDocuments\5DEmbroidery\MyDesigns folder as Sunrise Apartments.vp3 then click Save
- 84. Click Send 1 ₺ to send the design directly to your creative vision™ or as configured in 5D™ Configure.
