

## 5D™ Embroidery Software Owner's Class

## 5D™ Embroidery Extra 'Store Logo for Shirt'


- Open 5D™ Embroidery Extra <sup>5</sup>
- 2. Click Hoop ...
- 3. Set the Hoop Group to Pfaff<sup>®</sup> creative vision<sup>™</sup>.
- 4. Set the Hoop Size to 120mm x 120mm creative 120 Square Hoop.
- 5. Set the Orientation to Vertical then click OK.
- 6. Click Preferences .
- Set the Grid Size to 10mm, leave Remove Overlap When Combining Embroideries and Check Spelling checked then click OK.
- 8. Click the drop down arrow next to ExpressDesign Wizard 2 and choose Fit in Rectangle 2.
- 9. Click and drag a box that is 5 boxes wide and 5 boxes tall then release. The ExpressDesign Wizard box will open.
- 10. Leave Create Express Embroidery selected then click Next.
- 11. Click View Picture
- 12. Browse to Documents\5DEmbroidery\Samples\5DEmb\pics2\handbags then click OK
- 13. Select 1Cha006.png found in the second row, first column then click Next.
- 14. On the Rotate Picture page, change the Rotation to 45 degrees then click Next.
- 15. No additional cropping is needed, just click Next.
- 16. No further reduction of colors is needed, just click Next.
- 17. On the Choose Thread Colors page, click the drop down arrow next to Change All To and select Robison-Anton Rayon 40.
- 18. Under Background Color, select Automatically Remove Background Color and select Remove all background color areas then click Next.
- 19. This logo will be embroidered on polo shirts, so set the fabric to Knit.
- 20. Deselect Design Underlay because the design is small.
- 21. Under Preferred Stitch Type, leave the slider bar at Fill (0) then click Next.
- 22. On the Design Preview Page, click Finish.









- 23. Click and drag the purse until the right side of the selection box is along the first vertical grid line to the right of the solid center line.
- 24. Center the purse horizontally.




- 25. Click Find Designs 3.
- 26. Type 'Shoes' in the Containing box.
- 27. Make sure Filename and Notes are both checked.
- 28. Make sure Folder is set to Documents\5DEmbroidery then click Search.
- 29. Choose the second design found, click Load then click Close.
- 30. Drag the design into the hoop area so the top green shoe is visible.



- 31. Go to the Edit tab.
- 32. Under Select, choose Polygon Select .
- 33. Click around the green shoe only to select it.
- 34. Click Cut 34.
- 35. Click Make Block from Visible Area to select all the other shoes.
- 36. Click Delete X.
- 37. Click Paste 1 to paste the shoe back in.
- 38. Press the Tab key on your keyboard twice to select it. The purse will be selected first, then the shoe.
- 39. Click Make Block from Visible Area to select the shoe.
- 40. Click the triangle on the left side of the selection box to mirror image the shoe.
- 41. Click Resize 5.
- 42. Under Modify Block, change the Height % to 60 and the Width % to 60 then click Apply.
- 43. Click Resize 造 again to turn it off.
- 44. With the shoe still selected type 33 in the Angle box then click Apply.



- 45. Move the shoe to overlap the purse as shown.
- 46. Go back to the Design tab.
- 47. Click Combine All ...
- 48. Go to the Letter tab.
- 49. Set the Category to Script.
- 50. Leave Adina 12-40mm selected.
- 51. Leave the Size at 12 mm.
- 52. In the Letters box, type 'A Girl's Best Friend'.
- 53. Choose Circle Clockwise for the Line Type.
- 54. Make sure the embroidery design is selected on screen.



- 55. Click Apply. Notice the lettering snaps to the embroidery design!
- 56. Back in the Letters box, click and drag on the lettering and delete it. Then type 'Boutique.'
- 57. Choose Arch Under ≥.
- 58. Make sure the purse and shoe design is selected and then click Apply.
- 59. Go to the Design tab.
- 60. With the lettering selected, hold down the Ctrl key on your keyboard and select the purse and shoe and the top lettering. Notice there is no color information in the Color Select area because multiple designs are selected.
- 61. Click the drop down arrow next to Center in Hoop 


  and choose Align Center 

  .
- 62. Click Combine All then click Center in Hoop ...
- 63. Go the Motif tab.
- 64. Under Motif, set the Group to Pfaff.
- 65. Set the Category to 1.5 U Bartack.
- 66. Set the Pattern to 4.
- 67. Leave the Height and Width as is then click Apply.
- 68. Go back to the Design tab.
- 69. With the diamond selected, click Rotate 90° €.
- 70. Click Encore ...
- 71. Set the Type to Line and the Position to Standard.
- 72. Under Line Options, click the drop down arrow and choose line 7.
- 73. Set the Number of Repeats to 10. Leave ColorSort and Remove Overlap selected then click OK.
- 74. Drag the whole selection box down to the lower half of the design, lining up the first diamonds directly under the top lettering.









- 75. Click and drag the blue square on the right side of the box to stretch the diamonds out.
- 76. Click on the blue square on the top of the box to stretch the diamonds off of the word 'Boutique' making sure they stay within the hoop area.
- 77. When happy with the position of the diamonds, right click to set the Encore.
- 78. Click Combine All sthen ColorSort st.
- 79. Click on the blue diamond color block. Under Thread Range, click the drop down arrow and choose Owner's Class.
- 80. Select the SuMe3-7009 (Pewter) then click OK.
- 81. Click on the green color block and change it to the same SuMe3-7009 (Pewter) then click OK.
- 82. Click ColorSort 33.
- 83. Click Background Wizard 22.
- 84. Under Background choose Load Previously Saved.
- 85. Under Type choose Garment then click Next.
- 86. On the Load Background page, click View



- 87. Browse to Garments\General\T-ShirtsPolo2\ then click OK.
- 88. Select Pink Light T Shirt.gbg then click Finish.
- 89. Click View Mode 10 to switch to Realistic 3D 30
- 90. Click Move Background .....
- 91. Move the pink shirt so the logo falls to the right of the center button and below the shoulder.
- 92. Click Save As and save the design in your MyDocuments/5DEmbroidery/MyDesigns folder as Logo for Shirt.vp3 then click Save.
- 93. Click Send 1 to send the design directly to your creative vision™ or as configured in 5D™ Configure.
